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GLOBAL CORPORATE CITIZENSHIP PROGRAMME (GCCP) SUMMARY

- A fast-track pathway to Cayman Islands Residency within 6–8 weeks
- Most cost-efficient route to residency: initial (year 1) set up costs typically US\$22,000- US\$24,000. Annually (year 2 +) averaging US\$18,500
- Based on incorporation of Special Economic Zone Company (SEZCo) in approved sector and obtaining renewable 5-year zone permit for the applicant and residency visas for all dependents
- No mandatory property investment
- No minimum stay requirement
- Tax-neutral environment (no corporate, income, or capital gains tax)
- Includes access to a fully serviced CEC office facilities and operational infrastructure
- Import concessions for business equipment

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ZONE ONE: TECH CITY

Includes businesses actively trading or investing in technology, software development, fintech, biotechnology, blue technology and green technology

Option for passive investment businesses which own ships / yachts, or aircraft


OR business actively trading in maritime or aviation business such as chartering and transportation of aircraft or ships / yachts or managing their crew etc.

Onboarding and Timings

- Incorporation of new SEZCO by Sinclair Group within 24 hours of last to be received of onboarding and compliance documentation and payment of fees.
- Completing CEC's licencing agreement, onboarding and compliance documentation, and grant of CEC trade permit: Estimated 6-7 weeks.
- Grant of employment certificate (residency visa) to applicant and residency visas to family members: Estimated 1 week from grant of trade permit.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- 1. Can I bring my family?** Yes, residency visas will be granted to the spouse of applicant, children under 18 (or 24 if still in full-time education).
- 2. Do I have to pay an additional fee for dependents?** No, but they must have medical insurance, and children must attend private school or be home-schooled (they may not attend Government schools).
- 3. Is there a minimum number of days I must be in the Cayman Islands?** No, you can come and go as you like. The GCC Programme confers the right to live in the Cayman Islands, not the obligation to do so.
- 4. Can I open a bank account?** Yes, banking is available at Cayman retail banks for the company and for personal accounts, providing the applicant director/ shareholder also has a Cayman residential address.
- 5. Are there any other requirements?** Yes, CEC applicants must be able to provide a police clearance certificate (or equivalent), to satisfy compliance KYC requirements and undertake a routine medical (which may be undertaken off-Island).
